Vet Science Project

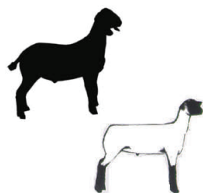
The Vet Science Project will meet on October 19, 2010 at the County Extension Office at 6:00 pm.
